ADVENT 2016. Our week began with our Advent assembly. I led the children in revisiting the symbolism of the Advent wreath and a discussion about the meaning of Advent. The first part of Advent focusses on our preparations for Jesus coming again whilst the later part of the season is when we consider Jesus being born in Bethlehem.
