Building Update. Testing of the ground where the new extension is to go was completed earlier this week. No issues arose so the original timescale set out is still very much on track. I have also received confirmation from the city council that the improved and enlarged standing area (by the gates) is to be completed over half term. Cashless school. From January 2018 it is hoped that the school will become a “cashless school”. We are currently investigating ways that families can pay dinner money/milk money and trips electronically. There are a number of systems that offer families the opportunity to pay via a link on the school website using a credit/debit card. This should make paying trip/milk/dinner money much easier for both school and parents. As soon as I know more I will write separately to everyone, the aim is however to make the school “cashless” by January 2018.
