“Living Lent 2018”.

Dear Parents,

LENT 2018. Next Wednesday February 14th (Ash Wednesday) sees the start of Lent. Pope Francis wrote that

“Lent is a favourable season for deepening our spiritual life through fasting, prayer and charitable giving”.

Indeed it is the ideal time to think of those less fortunate than ourselves and to do something about it. The season of Lent lasts 40 days; this reminds us of the time Jesus spent in the wilderness. During this time Jesus grew stronger, Lent offers all of us the same opportunity to grow stronger as our journey of faith continues.

Ash Wednesday. Our next school Mass will be next **Wednesday 14th** to mark the beginning of Lent, Y2-Y6 will gather in church whilst EYFS and Y1 will lead a prayer service in school. At Mass/prayer service the children will receive ashes on the foreheads to mark the beginning of the Lenten season, a season that lasts up until Easter Day at the beginning of April.

School Mass. Thanks to Y1 for leading our Mass this morning.

Building Update. Work on the expansion of school begins on **Monday February 19th** (half term week). From after half term accessing school via the drive will not be possible. Any families that use the breakfast club will need to park on the car park and walk up the drive, visitors to school will need to do likewise.
