<u>Alton Castle 2019 Monday September 16th – Wednesday September 18th.</u> I hope everyone is packed and raring to go next Monday. As indicated in previous letters the children need to bring their bag with them to school on Monday morning. They will then leave after lunch at 2.30pm approximately. Can I reiterate that <u>electronic gadgetry of any kind whatsoever is not permitted</u>, these are lost and or broken which can lead to great distress.
