ADVENT 2019. Our week will begin on Sunday with our Family Mass. We will light the first purple candle, which symbolises *'hope'*. We can have hope because God is faithful and he will keep the promises he made to us. Indeed our hope comes from God! Thank you in advance to Mr Barton for organising our Mass. In assembly on Monday, we will light the first candle on our Advent wreath and celebrate all the Advent promises we have made in class.
