<u>Y5/6 Mass</u>

Thank you to Mr Mulligan and the Y5 and Y6 teachers for overseeing the pupils at mass today. It was an exemplary mass to start us off on our term ahead. We prayed for Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II to mark the first anniversary of her passing. We celebrated the Birthday of Our Lady and prayed for all who are beginning a new academic year at St Margaret Mary School.

School Routines

Welcome back to all pupils new and old. Overview letters have been sent out today along with PE information. Children will come to school wearing black leggings/joggings, white T-shirt and school jumper/cardigan. They will need pumps for PE to be brought into school or worn on the day of their lesson. EYFS will have PE on a Monday, Y1 Monday, Y2 and Y3 Tuesday and Y4 and Y5 on Thursdays, Y6 on Wednesdays.

Milk/Juice/Dinners

A reminder that lunches in Nursery are paid for by parents and school provide milk. In Reception parents pay for milk and receive a free school dinner. We are unable to provide milk to children if and when their milk balance reaches £15.00 similarly for school dinners. We ask that parents ensure payments are made weekly to avoid large debts accruing. Children in Y5 and Y6 can choose an apple juice option twice a week if they so wish. This will be charged to ParentPay if a child requests juice.

<u>Uniform</u>

It is great to see all our pupils return with the appropriate uniform. Children no longer are required to wear branded cardigans and jumpers. Red garments will suffice if you wish to purchase non branded uniform. Black shoes for all pupils, no trainers. A polite reminder that no jewellery is to be worn to school. We ask that earrings are not worn to school. Children can wear digital/analogue watches but not smart watches. Many thanks for your support.

PSHE Day

Thank you to Miss Winchurch for organising our PHSE day on Wednesday with the theme 'Being me in My World.' The children from Nursery to Y6 have investigated topics ranging from knowing their own identify, feeling special and safe, mapping hopes and dreams, setting goals for the new year ahead. KS2 focused on working as a team and the qualities needed to be a good citizen and to feel valued.


