Design & Technology	Design and construct a Viking Long-ship as well as Viking helmets; using a variety of joining and reinforcement techniques to strengthen structures.
History	Research important Viking Events, Dates and Raids, Life of Edward the Confessor and Athelstan's contribution to History.
Computing	E-Safety-reporting concerns, Using Search technologies effectively And Evaluating Digital Content, Presenting Data and Information
Geography	Viking Settlements and Land Use, Trade Links and Distribution of Natural Resources. Mapping of Journeys of Vikings.
Music	Learn and perform a variety of hymns and songs linked to topics with control of diction and pitch. Be able to use percussion instruments with increasing control. Brass Instrument lessons with Mr Bernie.
