RE	Jesus: Light of the World and Beloved Son –Know the stories of Baptism, presentation and Transfiguration of Jesus, Understand the symbols of the Baptismal Liturgy, Old Testament : Moses- King David- understand role of Moses and David in the OT Bible Stories and how to respond to God's Call today
English	Reading, comprehension and examination of features of play-scripts including stage directions, Evaluating evidence. Studying the conventions of biographies. Spelling/Punctuation/Grammar: paragraphs, sub-headings, inverted commas, determiners, fronted adverbials, pronouns, apostrophes, plurals, verbs. Read and spell words from Year 3/4 common exception word list
Maths	Number, Multiplication and Division, Comparing and Ordering of Fractions and decimals, Fraction and decimal equivalents, Problem-solving with increasingly larger numbers, fractions and decimals, Interpreting and presenting data, Perimeter and Area, Recall of multiplication facts up to 12x12 Weekly- Number of the week
Spanish	Telling the Time- What's the time? Recall of numbers up to 50 including multiples of 10 up to 100 Read and respond to Spanish stories and rhymes. Develop pronunciation.
PE	Multi-Skills: running, jumping, throwing and catching. Applying these skills to games. Swimming (4A Spring 1 4P Spring 2) Develop their swimming skills. Practise a range of stroke techniques and develop confidence with swimming in deeper water.
Art	Artist study- Kandinsky- research life and work, examine use of patterns in artwork and recreate style of Kandinsky using charcoal, paint and digital art. Artist Study- Chagall – research life and work, recreate style using pencils, paint and digital art. Artists comparisons- debate favourite and why
Design & Technology	Focus on hygiene in the kitchen, Cooking- Plan and prepare a hot savoury dish and a cold dish. Evaluate dishes and consider steps for improvement
Computing	E-Safety-reporting concerns, Using Search technologies effectively And Evaluating Digital Content, Presenting Data and Information to an audience- link to Science – Solids, liquids and Gasses and Geography- Research on volcanoes and earthquakes
Geography/History	Investigate physical features in UK and Europe and draw comparisons, Describe and understand volcanoes and earthquakes, Understand the Water Cycle.
Music	Learn and perform a variety of hymns and songs linked to topics with control of diction and pitch. Be able to use percussion instruments with increasing control. Brass Instrument lessons with Mr Bernie. Develop use of staff notation.
Science	Material changes- identify characteristics of different materials and sort, Compare solids, liquids and gasses and investigate how different materials can change.
