

KS2 Curriculum Overview

Year Group: 6

Term: Autumn 1

Topic: Monarchy and Government	
Art	Study pieces of architecture, royal portraits and artwork displayed in the Houses of Parliament. Recreate these pieces using a range of media and techniques.
Computing	Presentations Locate information on a monarch of their choice. Check the validity of the information gained. Create a non-linear presentation on their chosen monarch.
English	Legends and Journalistic Writing Explore and analyse the features of these texts. Use this knowledge to draft and write texts.
Geography	Build upon their knowledge of the UK. Use the eight points of a compass, grid references, symbols and keys through map work.
History	Study the history of Monarchy and Government Explore the changing power of monarchs and the changes they brought to Britain. Study the Magna Carta and the reign of King John.
Music	Musical Instruments: Experiment with patterns and rhythms. Understand musical notation. Focused Listening to Music and Singing: Discuss pieces of music using a musical vocabulary.
Maths	Number, Fractions and Problem Solving Work with place value and word problems that contain multi-operations and steps. Develop work with arithmetic: Explain how they gained answers and their reasoning.
PE	Swimming Develop their swimming skills. Practise a range of stroke techniques and develop confidence with swimming in deeper water.
RE	The Story of the People of God and Followers of Christ Explore the structure of the Bible and the events that happened during these times. Know why these events are important and what they mean for us.
Spanish	Spanish Writing Explore the music that is common within Spanish culture. Learn vocabulary and write sentences in Spanish.
