

## KS2 Curriculum Overview

**Year Group: 6**

**Topic: Sutton Park**

**Term: Summer 2**

<b><u>Subject:</u></b>	<b><u>We are learning about:</u></b>
Religious Education	The children will identify the role of Mary and we will celebrate her life and ministry. We will celebrate the life of the church and the role that the church has in our life and our community. We will identify symbols of eternal life in both the funeral and baptism service. The children will know about the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. They will identify the different symbols of the Holy Spirit and the role they play in the Sacrament of Confirmation.
Numeracy	Children will look at the topics of rounding to whole and decimal numbers, identify different properties of 2D and 3D shapes including how to construct them using nets. We will solve problems involving similar shapes and scale. We will convert miles to kilometres and vice versa. We will also concentrate upon knowing and using our times tables.
Literacy	Children will read and explore the work of William Shakespeare. We will identify different themes in his writing. They will study the characters used within his plays and the reasoning behind their actions. We will continue to develop our creative and imaginative writing through the use of the writing process..
Science	We will recognise that light travels in straight lines. We will investigate how light travels into our eye so we can see. We will explain how shadows are formed and how because light travels in straight lines they are in the shape of the object.
Computing	Using the internet safely to research the history of Sutton Park. We will be using different software packages to program a specific outcome. We will create and program a game by using the scratch program. We will also continue to use the SMART rules to keep ourselves safe online.
Spanish	In our Spanish sessions this term we will be identifying the names of different countries and regions. We will learn how to give directions and to travel upon different forms of transport.
Art	We will study the art form cubism. The children this term will look at the life of Picasso and create a biography based upon his work. We will also identify some of his most famous pieces of artwork and we will create our own version of these.
Geography	The children will identify the key features and land use of Sutton Park. They will use the four cardinal points of the compass to describe these key features and they will be able to orientate a map to suit their goal.
History	This term the children will look at the history and development of Sutton Park from its use as a hunting park in the time of Henry VIII to the role it played in the first and second world war.
Music	In our music session we will continue to play tuned instruments in ensemble contexts such as the glockenspiel and we will learn a variety of songs to be used both in Mass and to support our work in class.
PE	This term we will learn and play the game of rounders. We will develop our knowledge of the rules of the game and explore the importance of fair play. We will also take part in orienteering in Sutton Park.
