Sacramental Programme 2016-2017. Mrs Hayes will be writing to everyone in Y3 and Y6 shortly with all the relevant dates/times/meetings for the year ahead. Secondary Transfer 2017. A reminder that the online admissions web site is now open and the secondary school open sessions are about to begin. Y6 parents have until the 31st October to submit their application form, if any family needs to talk or is unsure about this process please come in to school for a chat. It is a very important decision and my advice would be to visit all your potential schools.

School numbers. Our school is currently full to capacity in every year group. Sadly this week I have had to meet with a number of families telling them that we have "no room" left in school. If you have a child in Nursery or you have a child of school age in September please make sure you fill in our supplementary information form. These are separate to local authority forms and can be downloaded from our website or collected from the school office. This form gives school the information that your child is a baptised Catholic, without it school will not know and a place cannot be offered. Please call into school and fill in a form to guarantee your place.

School Uniform. Thank you for sending the children back to school looking so smart in their red uniforms. Thank you for your support with our uniform policies, it really is a tradition we can all be rightly proud of. Can I remind everyone that NO jewellery of any kind is permitted in school and that trainers are not allowed. Thank you to everyone for your support with these matters. Autumn 16 Dates. <u>Nursery/Reception 2016-2017.</u> Well done to all our new children for settling in so well, well done also to the EYFS staff for all their efforts and hard work this week.

**Dinner Money 2016-2017.** The cost for dinners is £11 a week and needs to be paid on a Monday either by posting the money into the box provided in the entrance area, or by handing it in to the school office.

<u>Milk Money 2016-2017</u>. The cost of milk is £1.30 per week; please do encourage your child/children to have milk as a healthy option. Likewise with break time snacks please can I ask you to encourage your children to have a healthy snack.

**Breakfast Club 2016-2017.** The cost per day is £3 or £5 for siblings. Mrs Teague runs our breakfast club and opens it at 7.45am each morning.
