Dear Parents.

Family Mass. A final reminder that everyone is invited to our Mass this Sunday the 25th. Both Father Simon and I extend a warm welcome to everyone to come along and join us. This Mass will be an ideal opportunity to welcome Father Simon to our parish, to say hello to all our new families and for all of us to start our new year together as a school family. Bishop Byrne is coming along to the Mass on Sunday so please do your utmost to come and support our school and parish as we begin 2016-2017 together.

Assembly. This week Mr Barton led the school with our first "Gospel Values" assembly of the year. This morning he concentrated on being *curious and active* in all we say and do. Mr Barton told the children the story of Mother (now Saint) Teresa's life, she said once that we don't have to do great things but we can do the little things well. Indeed this is one of the quotes from St Teresa in our main corridor and something that would enable all of us to be curious and active this half term.

Year of Mercy. We are still in the Year of Mercy (it concludes in November) and throughout the year we have talked about, displayed and focussed upon the different aspects of what it means to be in the Year of Mercy. This morning Y6 visited St Chads Cathedral and took part with lots of other schools in a special Liturgy. Thanks to Miss McCarron and Mr Barton for overseeing this.

Class Mass. Thank you to Y2 for our Mass this morning, next week (30th) will see Y6 lead our KS2 Mass. Sacramental Programme 2017. Mrs Hayes will write to Y3 and Y6 next week with all the dates and times for Reconciliation, Holy Communion and Confirmation now that all the dates have been settled. We are making some refinements to the programme this year so please make sure you receive a letter. If by any chance you have not received a letter by next Friday please call into the school office for a copy.

Reception 2017. We have only just started this year and the process for next year has now begun. The On line admissions website is already open and this term will see lots of schools host their open days/afternoons (ours is on *November 17th at 1.30pm*). Families have until December 4th to make their application with April 2017 being the time when offers will be sent out. At St Margaret Marys we already have 40 children that have applied for places. Bearing this in mind it is **ESSENTIAL** that families who seek a place in our school next year fill in a supplementary information form (downloaded from the website or collected from the school office). A substantial proportion on the list for 2017 are also baptized Catholics so if anyone is seeking a baptism for their child then they need to speak to Father Simon as a matter of urgency (0121 373 0069) after one of the weekend or daily Masses. Please can I ask anyone who has or knows someone that has a child of school age for September to please take note of the above; in particular if your child is not currently a baptized Catholic, I am also always available to discuss any of the above in school.

Safeguarding. It is of the utmost importance that all our children are kept safe. At school we have received a significant amount of training about how to make our procedures as robust as they possibly can be. All the staff received further training on Wednesday evening after school and all relevant policies are displayed on the website. It is the duty of EVERYONE to keep our children safe, "if in doubt raise it!!"

I wanted to remind everyone that during this period there will be an inevitable increase in traffic so please take extra care (particularly on Dovedale road). Building sites are also dangerous places so please make sure the children stay away from the site both during the week and at weekends. Lovells are coming into school to deliver an assembly in October about the work that is ongoing and we will be taking some children to visit the site after Christmas.
