Dear Parents,

Easter 2017. Welcome Back!! Our return to school has seen the Easter season continue on. Sunday’s Gospel will tell the story of the time when two of Jesus’ apostles initially failed to recognise him on the road to Emmaus. Recognising what is truly important is often a difficulty for all of us perhaps as the thought for the week points out, “an open mind” might help all of us.

First Holy Communion. Saturday May 20th at 9.00am/11.00am Our workshop takes place next **Thursday May 4th at 1.30pm**. Mr Barton will lead the session and talk about how the day is going to be organised.

School Mass. Thanks to Mr Barton for overseeing our Mass this morning. Next Friday (5th) Y5 will lead our Liturgy.

Sacrament of Confirmation Thursday June 22nd at 7.00pm. The Workshop before Confirmation will be held on **Wednesday June 14th**.

School Meals. I write on a regular basis about the need for families not to build up substantial debts with regard to dinner money. ***I need to also advise all KS2 families that the price of a school meal has gone up by 5p to £2.25 a day which is £11.25 per week.***

Summer Uniform. The office has asked me to tell everyone that items of summer uniform are available from the school office. Mrs Clegg/Mrs Cooney will be happy to help anyone who needs any items of uniform.

Reception 2017-2018. We will write shortly to those concerned about the induction process for next September.

PE Kits. Please can I ask for PE kits to remain in school, without them the children can miss out on their PE lessons.

Alton Castle 2017. We will be arriving at the castle in just over 4 months time. I would remind everyone that they can start to pay for the residential from now onwards. Maybe a certain amount each month could help spread the cost. Please call into the office and talk to Mrs Cooney and Mrs Clegg and they will help you if you want to start paying for the trip now. Starting to pay now would enable families to pay £20 per month or £5 a week for example up to the date of departure which may be more preferable than £85 in September.
