Dear Parents,

<u>Family Mass Sunday 17th September 10.00am.</u> Everyone is invited to our Mass on Sunday 17th. Both Father Simon and I extend a warm welcome to everyone to come along and join us. This Mass will be an ideal opportunity to say hello to all our new families and for all of us to start our new year together as a school family.

<u>Parish Fun Day Saturday September 9th 12.00-3.00pm.</u> A reminder that the parish are hosting a "fun day" tomorrow (Saturday). Please do come along there will be lots of activities and fun for everyone. Hopefully it will be dry!

<u>Secondary Transfer 2018</u>. A reminder that the online admissions web site is now open and the secondary school open sessions are about to begin. Y6 parents have until the end of October to submit their application form, if any family needs to talk or is unsure about this process please come in to school for a chat. It is a very important decision and my advice would be to visit all your potential schools.

School numbers/building Phase 1 of the building work is complete and Y6 are in their new temporary home. The temporary classroom was erected and completed just before we returned to school. Miss McCarron has since worked tirelessly in getting it ready for the children to work in, I am indebted to her (and Mrs Slattery) for all their efforts. Phase 2 (the car park/new entrance) is very nearly ready. The land next to the Church has now been significantly redeveloped and will prove a much better car parking facility for both school and parish. I hope this will be open sometime next week; I will let everyone know accordingly via group text when we can start using it. On opening the car park the children will enter and exit school through a different gate, this is also now ready to use once the car park is opened. This new entrance will give everyone much more space and thus improve the safety of everyone before and after school. The school drive will then become vehicle access only. I will write a separate letter to everyone when we will start to use the new entrance, hopefully this will be some time in the next fortnight. Phase 3 the new playground is beginning late autumn likewise the extension to school will begin before Christmas. Hopefully the work should all be completed late spring early summer 2018.
