Logging in will require an email address primarily, and needs to be completed next week. ParentPay will then go live the following *Monday* (*December* 4^{th}) for school dinners only. From Monday 11th December families that use the breakfast club will be able to pay via ParentPay with the idea being that when we return in January the school is a cash free school.

I am indebted to Mrs Cooney and Mrs Clegg in the office, setting up this payment system has taken up much of their recent time and to have it ready now to start using is a tremendous feat, many thanks to both. Shortly our website will have a direct link that will take you to the ParentPay homepage. It will also have some introductory information about how to use ParentPay. If anybody has any questions/queries about parent pay then please don't hesitate to contact school.

It is a means by which school can share good news and information about your child's learning via an App. This information will then come straight to your smartphone once the App has been downloaded. It is free to use so I urge you to download the App when we send you the relevant information, it is our intention to go live well before Christmas so please look out for the letter in the next week or two. It really is a wonderful way of school sharing good news with you immediately so you know what your child has done today. Indeed you get pinged when your child has done something marvellous, you can share the app with grandparents and you can send back Hi5's to school.
