ADVENT 2017. Our week began on Sunday with our Family Mass. It was wonderful to see so many families join us to celebrate the first week of Advent. We lit the first purple candle which symbolises 'hope'. We can have hope because God is faithful and he will keep the promises he made to us. Indeed our hope comes from God! Thank you to Mr Barton for organising our Mass. In assembly on Monday we lit the first candle on our Advent wreath and celebrated all the Advent promises we have made in class. We talked together about the symbols on the Advent wreathe, it is circular in shape because like God's love a circle has no beginning and no end; it is covered in evergreens to show that God's love is also everlasting and finally that there are different coloured candles that represent different ideas, this week being "hope". Advent is divided into two parts waiting for Jesus to come again (hence the need to be awake), and waiting for Jesus to be born on Christmas day. Advent is a time to get ready, a time to prepare and a time to remember that "Jesus is the reason for the season".
