<u>Easter 2018.</u> The Easter season continues, and at school we will be focussing upon the events leading up to Pentecost. Our assemblies will consider the events after Easter Sunday up until the Holy Spirit came down upon the Apostles. This will begin on Monday when the assembly will focus on "Good Shepherd Sunday". Mass this morning spoke to us about the importance of being witnesses, Father Simon spoke about the different kinds of witnesses there are and how we could all be witnesses of the truth here at St Margaret Marys.

This term will also have as its primary focus the Sacramental Programme. In May Y3 will be making their First Holy Communion whilst in July Y6 will be receiving the gifts of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation. Mr Barton has written to all Y3 families as to how Communion will now be organised. There will be three separate Masses over two weekends on May 12<sup>th</sup> and May 19<sup>th</sup> respectively. The workshops in school however will be done in classes, Y3W (Miss Ward's class) will have their workshop on Wednesday May 2nd and 3R (Miss Riley's class) on Thursday May 3<sup>rd</sup>. If any Y3 family have not received a letter, then please call into school for a copy. **It is ESSENTIAL that each family is represented at the respective workshop as at each session Mr Barton will explain how each Mass is going to be organised.** 

<u>Car Park Update.</u> I spoke to the local authority again this week and have arranged to meet with their representatives next week. I stressed the need for the kerb to be lowered and widened at the entrance of the car park as soon as possible. They assured me that this work was going to happen soon.
