Family Mass Sunday September 22nd 10.00am. *Everyone is invited to our Mass on Sunday 22nd. Both Father Simon and I extend a warm welcome to everyone to come along and join us.* This Mass will be an ideal opportunity to say hello to all our new families and for all of us to start our new year together as a school family.

Y2&Y5 Mass. Thanks to the children in Y2/5 for leading our Mass this morning. Next Friday (27th), it will be the turn of Y4 and Y1.

Secondary Transfer 2019-2020. A further reminder that the online admissions website is now open and the secondary school open sessions are about to begin. Y6 parents have until the end of October to submit their application form. If any family needs to talk or is unsure about this process please come in to school for a chat. It is a very important decision and my advice would be to visit all your potential schools.

School numbers. Each year group is now completely full; there is however, a pressing need for any families who require a place in Reception/Nursery next year (September 2020) to fill in our “Supplementary Information Form”. If this form is not filled in, it is likely that your child will not secure a place at St Margaret Marys. ***I cannot stress enough the need to come into the school office (or download it from the website) and complete our school form.*** Currently Nursery is 84 % Catholic, most of whom will be transferring to Reception in 2020. The current Reception classes are 65% Catholic so places will be at an absolute premium next year (despite having two classes). Please make sure you fill in one of our forms if you are intending to apply for September 2020.

Alton Castle 2019 Everyone returned safely on Wednesday afternoon! They were in need of some sleep and all had enjoyed a wonderful time at Alton Castle. The staff told me that the children were a credit to take away and they represented our school in exemplary fashion. Well Done to all of them!!
