ADVENT 2019. The lighting of candles on an Advent wreath dates back to the sixteenth century. The first week of Advent saw the first candle lit, a candle of "hope". In certain traditions this second purple candle is known as the "Bethlehem candle" to represent the manger i.e. "Love". As the third week approaches this Sunday, a different coloured candle will be lit. The pink candle represents "Joy", it is also known as the shepherd's candle after the angel appeared to the shepherds bringing them news that would bring great joy.
