First Holy Communion 2020 *Congratulations to Charlotte, Megan, Shae, Mason, Sesuna and Violet who all made their First Holy Communion this morning*. With everything we are all trying to deal with it was nice to be able to focus once again on the children receiving Jesus for the first time. The current Y4 were unable to receive the sacrament back in May due to the lockdown, so it really was important that that this was rectified as soon as possible. Over the next five weeks, the remainder of Y4 will make their First Holy Communion in small groups as per the guidelines.
