Dear Parents,

Welcome Back. The children have settled well back into school and have enjoyed their first week. As I wrote earlier school still has to operate with certain restrictions in place. We have to remain in our year group bubbles, reduce social contact, try to socially distance and all staff are continuing to be tested twice a week. I hope that things will ease further before July and if not by then certainly by next September. As I write, we have no positive cases across school and if we all continue to stick to the rules, I am sure this will continue to be the case for the rest of the summer term.

Sacramental Programme 2021. School is about to embark on its ambitious programme of First Holy Communion and Confirmation in May, June and July. The primary aim is to make sure all the children that are due to make their First Holy Communion this year actually do so. Organising this alongside the current restrictions has been very challenging, I am very grateful to Father Simon and Mr Barton for their help with these matters. The remaining Y4 children that still haven't made their First Holy Communion will receive the sacrament this half term whilst Y3 will make their First Holy Communion after the half term break. Father Simon and I must insist that only two adults attend the masses to comply with the current restrictions. This will remain the case for all of the masses between now and July. A footnote to this is that if any family wants to take the day away from school for a special meal/celebration after mass then please feel free to do so. All I ask is that you let Mr Barton or I know what your plans are.

Confirmation will be over two masses 5:00pm and 7:00pm on June 9th, again Father Simon and I must insist on only two parents attend to ensure we comply with current restrictions. **PE/Swimming** School hopes to start swimming again during the week beginning Monday May 3rd. The plan is to begin again with the Y6 bubble in small groups and see how it progresses. The swimming timetable however will only fully return to normal next September. A reminder also to please ensure all PE kits are in school.



PSHE Day. Thanks to Mrs Attwood for overseeing our lovely PSHE day on Monday. It was a lovely way to start the term.

<u>Music Lessons.</u> A reminder that Violin lessons take place on Tuesday and Brass lessons on a Friday. Please can those year groups involved make sure their instruments are in school on the relevant day.
