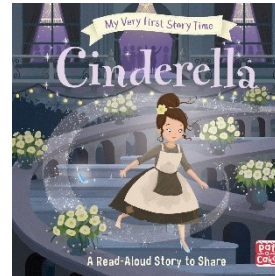
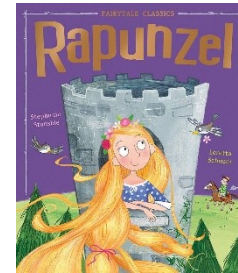
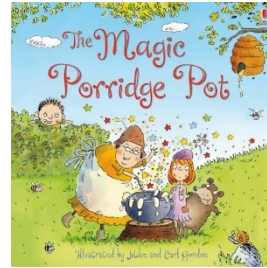
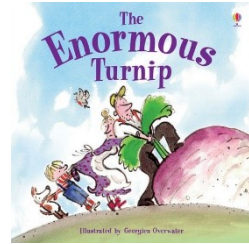


Key Knowledge

Traditional tales: a folk tale or fairy story which has been passed down for many generations and is well known within a particular culture.

Generations: all of the people born and living at about the same time

Life lessons: a situation in which you learn something useful about how to live your life.

Genres: a style or category of art, music, or literature

Plant: put a seed, bulb, or plant in the ground so that it can grow.

Kind: a way of doing good deeds through having a friendly, considerate, and generous nature
