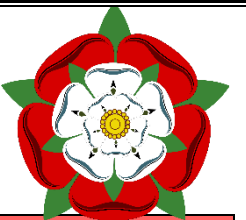
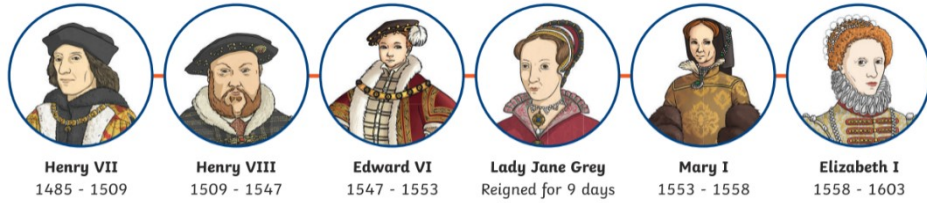


# Year 2, Spring 1: The Tudors

Henry VII 1485 - 1509  
Henry VIII 1509 - 1547  
Edward VI 1547 - 1553  
Lady Jane Grey Reigned for 9 days in 1553  
Mary I 1553 - 1558  
Elizabeth I 1558 - 1603

The Tudors were a royal family of **English kings and queens**. They ruled between **1485 and 1603**.



Tudor Rose: Designed by King Henry VII

The Houses of York and Lancaster were fighting because they both wanted to **rule England**. The symbol of the House of **York** was a **white rose**, and **Lancaster** had a **red rose**. Henry VII won the Wars of the Roses and **married Elizabeth of York** to spread peace. Their new rose was both red and white and it was called the **Tudor Rose**.

### The Five Oceans:

Queen Elizabeth sent Francis Drake on an expedition to the Americas.

Drake sailed the seas on a boat called **The Golden Hind**.

He took a journey with **164 men** to explore ships and items. His route has been plotted on the world map.



He was given a knighthood for his voyage around the globe.

## Vocabulary

<b>reign</b>	To rule as a monarch. For example, a king or queen reigns over their country.	
<b>Monarch</b>	A person who rules over a kingdom or place. For example: a king, queen or emperor.	
<b>artefacts</b>	A man-made object, such as pieces of art or tools that are of historical interest.	
<b>route</b>	A way of travel or movement: from point A to point B.	
<b>portrait</b>	Artwork of a person. Hans Holbein painted famous portraits of King Henry VIII.	
<b>connected device</b>	Electronic devices that can connect with each other via the internet. For example: Alexa, tablets, smart speakers and TVs.	
<b>balanced diet</b>	Eating the right amount of foods from the different food groups: carbohydrates, proteins, dairy and fruits and vegetables.	fats,
<b>composer</b>	A person who writes music. Thomas Morley was a composer who wrote <i>My Bonnie Lass</i> .
