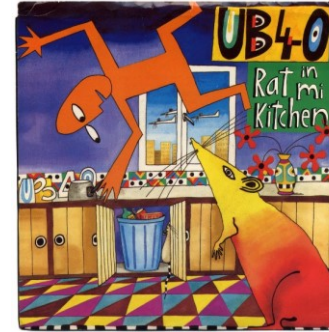


The British Broadcasting Corporation is a British public service broadcaster headquartered at the Broadcasting House in London, originally established in 1922.



Key Vocabulary

Album Artwork	The front packaging art of a studio album.
British Broadcasting Company	Radio, television and Internet company owned by the British Government.
Chassis	the base frame of a car, carriage, or other wheeled vehicle.
County	The counties of England are areas of land, cities and towns that are used for different purposes.
Genre	A style or category of music.
Melody	A sequence of single notes that makes a tune.
Dynamics	The variation in volume of the sounds or notes in a piece of music.
Hardware / Software	Physical parts that make up a computer. Programmes which tell a computer what to do.
