

Topic: The Vikings	
RE	Creation and covenant. Creation and Covenant helps pupils explore God as Creator and understand the special relationship between God and humanity. Through Scripture, prayer and reflection, pupils learn about creation, human dignity, responsibility for the world, and covenant, developing their ability to respond as discerning disciples. Gospel Virtues – Compassionate and Loving.
English	Exploring different types of poetry and poetic features. Writing non-chronological reports about Vikings life. Spelling/Punctuation/Grammar: dictation, paragraphs, prefixes/suffixes and homophones.
Maths	Number, Place Value, Addition and Subtraction. We will continue to learn all our times tables, and the matching division facts.
Spanish	We will be exploring 'Hispanic' countries as well as learning days of the week, months of the year and some daily routines along with learning the time. Emphasis this term will be for children to work on spoken Spanish with a developing pronunciation.
PE	Invasion Games – learn different passes, understand the rules and play Netball.
Art	Sketching Viking Artefacts and Settlements, using a variety of materials including sketching pencils, pastels, paint and charcoal. Use clay to sculpt artefacts.
Design & Technology	Design, make and evaluate biscuits.
History	Research important Viking Events, Dates and Raids, Life of Edward the Confessor and Athelstan's contribution to History.
Computing	Online-Safety-reporting concerns, Using Search technologies effectively And creating an online fact-file about the Vikings
Geography	Viking Settlements and Land Use, Trade Links and Distribution of Natural Resources. Mapping Vikings exploration.
Music	Learn and perform a variety of hymns and songs linked to topics with control of diction and pitch. Be able to use percussion instruments with increasing control. Begin brass Instrument lessons with Mr Ali.
Science	Living things and their habitats – Learn about the different life processes, use diagrams to classify animals into different groups, how animals adapt to their habitats, threats to animal habitats.
